Diana Lili Pinck has deep roots in the *Old Town of Lucerne*. For generations her mother's family thrived in this very neighbourhood. Her father however was American, so she was born in New York City, where she later studied Film and Television at New York University. At NYU Pinck learned how to tell stories in a single image, a quality that remains central to her work.

Pinck continued her artistic practice at the Art Students League of New York while working as an X-ray technologist. First exhibitions and prizes in both painting and photography soon followed. Later, while raising two sons she also worked as a Photographer and the Art & Travel Editor of 25A, a luxury-lifestyle magazine, in Long Island and NYC.

Since Pinck's return to Lucerne about ten years ago its landscapes and her friends have played starring roles in her art. Her paintings of Lucerne reflect both, the intimate familiarity of the local and the fresh eye of the traveler.
